

Parent Code of Conduct



As a parent/carer of a participant of Basketball Wales Club member you are expected to:

- Positively reinforce your child and show an interest in their chosen activity.
- Do not place your child under pressure or push them into activities they do not want to do.
- Complete and return the required registration forms to the Club
- Deliver and collect your child punctually before and after sessions or matches.
- Ensure your child has clothing, kit & refreshments appropriate to the session attended.
- Ensure that proper sportswear and protective equipment are worn. Any child not in possession of the fundamental requirements will not be permitted to participate.
- Detail any relevant medical concerns or conditions pertaining to their child on the registration form. Any changes in the state of the child's health should be reported to the Club Coach.
- Encourage your child to play by the rules and teach them that they can only do their best.
- Ensure that your child understands their Code of Conduct.
- Behave responsibly on the side-line; do not embarrass your child.
- Show appreciation and support the Club Coach & volunteers.
- Ensure your child is punctual.
- Be realistic and supportive.
- Do not coach from the side lines as this may contradict or confuse the information being given by the coach.
- Promote your child's participation in playing sport for fun.
- **As a parents/carer you have the right to:**
 - Be assured that your child is safeguarded during their participation in sport.
 - Be informed of problems or concerns relating to your child.
 - Be informed if your child is injured.
 - Have your consent sought for issues such as trips or photography.
 - Have any concerns about any aspect of your child's welfare listened to responded to.

Any breaches of this code of conduct will be dealt with immediately by the Club. Persistent concerns or breaches may result in you being asked not to attend training/matches. If your attendance is considered detrimental to the welfare of young participants you will also be requested not to attend training/matches.
